Expert Meeting on Sanfilippo Disease

This expert meeting on Sanfilippo disease offers individuals, parents, partners, carers and professionals the opportunity to hear state of the art talks on the clinical management of those affected by MPS III and members' personal experiences, as well as finding out more about the latest research developments and potential therapies.

The expert meeting programme offers the opportunity to meet and talk informally with professionals, and for individuals, parents, partners and carers to share their own experiences with others.

Children and vulnerable adults affected by Sanfilippo disease and their siblings aged 17 and under will have their own social programme, which will allow them to have fun whilst giving them the opportunity to talk to and make friends with others in similar circumstances.

The expert meeting is spread over two days from Friday to Saturday and will be the largest gathering of Sanfilippo sufferers, their families and professionals ever. Doctors and researchers will also be present.

Children and Vulnerable Adults Programme

No children under 18 years are permitted into the expert meeting. There will be a children and vulnerable adults activity programme arranged so that parents can attend the meetings in a relaxed manner knowing their children are safely cared for and entertained.

Given the high number of children and vulnerable adults expected to attend and the range of needs these individuals will have, the activity programme will be varied. We are hoping to allow some children and vulnerable adults to go out for periods of the day and others will have activities provided within the hotel complex.

Please note that it may not be possible for us to take out those who are no longer mobile or able to weight bear and those with complex needs such as requiring gastrostomy feeds, suctioning and who require complex care when out. Individuals will be assessed on an individual basis and any decision will be dependant on whether we are able to secure volunteers who have the experience to provide the level of care they require.

Evening Childrens & Vulnerable Adult care /Entertainment
Volunteers will be providing care on the Friday evening to allow parents to attend the gala dinner. Please note that at this stage we cannot guarantee we will be able to provide care in individual bedrooms and we may have to provide some form of entertainment within the hotel.

Volunteers will be at the conference throughout the expert meeting to support the children's and vulnerable adults programme; each volunteer has completed an application, two references and received clearance from the Criminal Records Bureau. Each volunteer is allocated a child/children/vulnerable adult and given all the information needed about the individual's needs. All parents/carers will be consulted over their child/children's needs and a care plan drawn up where needed. Volunteers receive training on moving and handling, advice on child protection and the Society's policy on Volunteer Conduct and are informed about the importance of respect and encouraging independence.

Childcare volunteers will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. If your child has complex healthcare needs please contact us before booking to discuss needs and resources required.

The Venue

The expert meeting venue is the Hilton Hotel Northampton, which is an open plan, spacious hotel. The hotel is ideally located just off Junction 15 of the M1 in the English countryside of Northamptonshire. **The bedrooms are spread over two levels and the ground floor bedrooms will be allocated on a first come first serve basis, with priority for ground floor access given to the more severely disabled as there is no lift to the first floor, and those booking for the whole expert meeting.** The bedrooms at the hotel can take between 2 and 5 people per room.

The hotel benefits from its own 18-metre indoor, heated swimming pool and Livingwell Health Club consisting of Sauna, Steam Room and Spa to relax in or, for the energetic type, the hotel offers a fully equipped gymnasium which will be available to all guests over the course of the weekend. Guests arriving on the Friday will be able to use the hotel facilities, however bedrooms are not guaranteed to be ready until 3pm.
